OBSERVATION

1. Explain Inductive Method (O, I, A)
2. Read Hebrews 1:1-4 (3 times)
3. Observation Questions
 - a. **Actions** *spoke, appointed, created, radiating glory, representing, sustaining, purifying, sat down, became superior)*
 - b. **Time** *past/present/future - created, prophets, purification, spoke (past), Son seated (now), inherit all things (future)*
 - c. **Cause & Effect** *created through Son, Son makes God known, sitting down becomes superior to angels*
 - d. **Contrast** *past vs now, prophets vs son, Son vs angels,*
 - e. **Compare** *God spoke past & now, prophets & son, deity of God & son*
 - f. **Progressions/Sequence** *Created, prophets spoke, Son spoke, purification of sin, sat down, inherit all things*
 - g. **Key word(s)** *Superior*
 - h. **Commands** *none*
